

## Graduate Programs in Environmental Science Application Checklist

The following 2 items are required when applying to the University of North Texas Graduate Program in Environmental Science:
1.Completed Robert B. Toulouse School of Graduate Studies Application for Admission form
( <u>www.ApplyTexas.org</u> ).
2.Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.
OPTIONAL: An Official copy of the GRE (Graduate Records Exam) scores (verbal and quantitative).
Item 2 and GRE scores (optional) should be mailed to: Toulouse School of Graduate Studies (TSGS), Admissions Section, University of North Texas, 1155 Union Circle #305459, Denton, TX 76203-5017.

Items 3, 4, 5 and 6 below are also required and should be completed through the program's
online application at <a href="https://environmentalscience.unt.edu/graduate-program/application-process">https://environmentalscience.unt.edu/graduate-program/application-process</a> .
3.Letter of support from an environmental science faculty member stating that he/she
agrees to be your major professor for the PSM, MS or PhD program if you are admitted to
the program. This is one of the most crucial requirements.
4. Three letters of reference from professors/associates who know your academic
qualifications. The major professor letter of support can serve as one of these letters.
5.A letter of intent detailing the exact nature of your interests in environmental science
and your career goals. Please make this letter as informative as possible because it is
seen as one of the most important documents in the application materials.
6.Relevant coursework. You may find this form to be helpful: Environmental Science
Application Data Sheet.
